Karolinum: Modrá posluchárna Opening Ceremony

Karolinum is a historic complex which serves as the central building of Charles University, founded in 1348. It is a significant cultural and educational landmark, known for its beautiful Gothic and Baroque architecture. Committee Sessions

The Charles University's Faculty of Law is a historical building with modern design, founded in 1348 as one of the first faculties of the university. Although it is old, the building itself represents a modern approach of the university to the architecture. It is also located next to the river Vltava, giving an awesome view of the city. As well as providing a stunning view, it offers very easy access due to its location in the New Town. We will have the honor to attend this incredible building during our committee sessions.

Security Council

Special Political and Decolonization Committee

- Addressing the territorial dispute over the region of Kashmir
- Reinforcement of the non-proliferation treaty and renewed nuclear disarmament efforts

- Destruction of world heritage sites during both armed conflicts and through other means as well as ensuring their accessibility to all people
- Ensuring better accessibility of and safety for aid workers in conflict areas

UNFCCC COP

- Addressing the ongoing crisis of desertification mainly in central Asia, Sahel and Amazonas regions

- Assessing ways to achieve global carbon neutrality before 2100 and devising binding legal measures to enforce this goal including focus on removing fraudulent carbon recapture schemes

- Devising measures to further promote and facilitate new means supporting informed purchasing decisions made by the end consumer

International Atomic Energy Agency

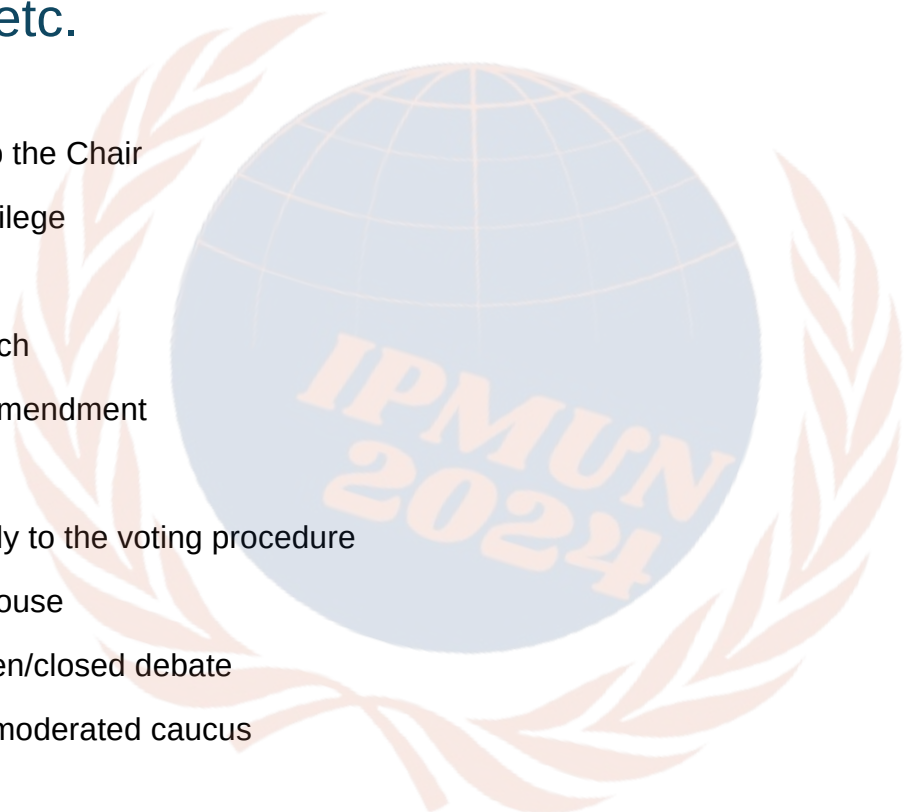
- Addressing Immediate Concerns and Containment Measures for the Fukushima Nuclear Incident.

THE BEGINNING

OPEN DEBATE

Resolution is presented by the main submitter → Points, Motions and Amendments are proposed → delegates hold speeches

CLOSED DEBATE

Time in favour and against are held

VOTING PROCEDURE

Voting is made upon the motion, amendment, after voting the Committee finds itself back in the Open Debate
Voting is made upon the entire resolution, another resolution then may be presented, or even a new topic

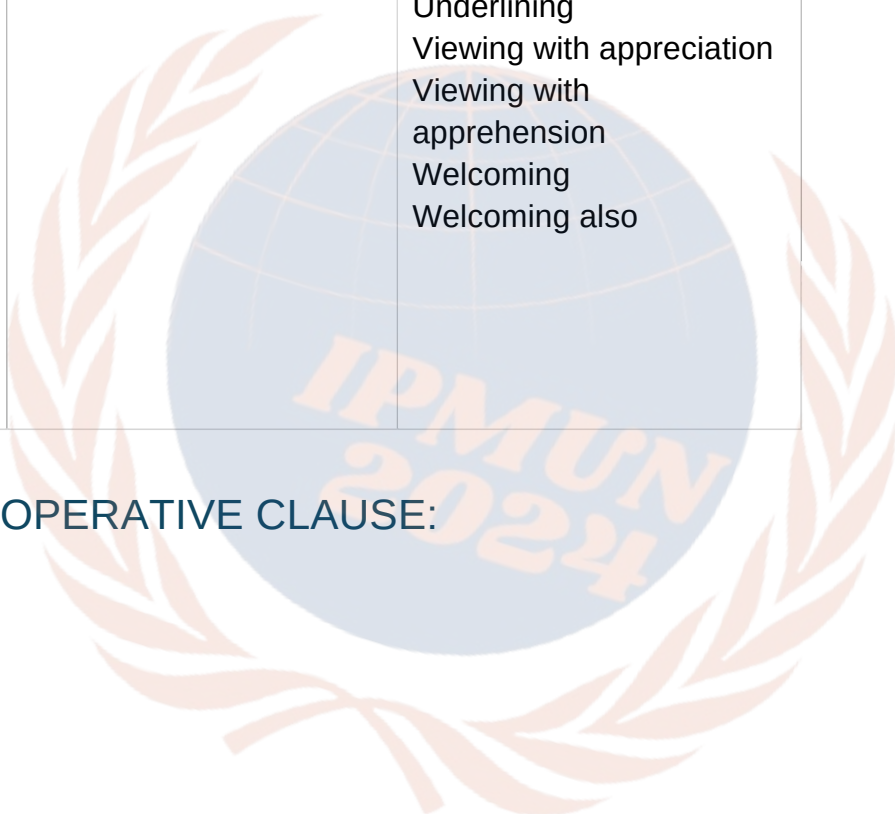
